## Concurrent Sessions

*(The Concurrent Sessions listed below are in 30-minute blocks of time and students will be rotated so they participate in all 5 sessions.)*

**“The Miracle of Corn”** – Students will observe above and below ground the miraculous growth of a corn plant, plus learn the story of corn as a source of fuel and food.

**“Wow That Cow”**- Students will learn how cattle affect our lives in Nebraska and all over the world! Topics range from production and ranching practices, to health and nutrition, to the products and by-products used each day.

**“The H2O Show”** – Students will interactively learn basic river and groundwater systems in Nebraska by working with a model of the Platte River system, plus review water cycle basics.

**“Educational Crops Exhibits”** – Students will participate and view Grains, 50 Years of Tractors, Technology, Hay Packages, and Farming Practices.

**“Educational Livestock Exhibits”** – Students will participate and view Sheep Shearing, Cattle Handling, Four Stomachs of a Cow, Moo To You, Pork Knowledge.

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
