Dear Shooting Sports Participants,

Shooting Sports is one of the largest projects in Dawson County. In an effort to improve our record keeping and make sure that all youth are registered for the disciplines that they intend to practice, we are implementing a shooting sports affidavit system in Dawson County. Each participant will be required to fill out a form certifying which disciplines they are taking and the appropriate shooting sports instructor they are receiving instruction from. In the past, youth have practiced in disciplines that they are not registered for and instructors did not know their status.

This year, the individuals will need to fill out forms and either mail or email (mwolffl 1@unl.edu) them to the Dawson County Extension Office after they are signed by the instructor or instructors of your choosing. This way, the instructors will know your intention to participate and the registrations can be cross-checked by the Extension Office. If you have not decided on your disciplines, include all that you might want to do. Remember, that instruction must be given by a qualified/certified Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports Instructor in the specific discipline. The certified instructor must be present at all practices of that discipline to count toward your 10 hours of instruction per year and to comply with the Nebraska 4-H rules. You may practice both BB gun and air rifle but must choose one or the other to participate in at the Dawson County Fair Shooting Sports Event.
