



At the Dixon County 4-H Council January 2022 meeting, it was decided to establish and enforce a Late Fee Policy for 2022, of \$5.00 per day fee (per family) for up to 5 business days. If this penalty is not paid by the end of the 5th business day, June 22, the family will not be permitted to show at any 2022 Dixon County Fair 4-H shows and contests.

If this policy is not followed during 2022, the 2023 Late Fee Policy will change from \$5.00 per late family to \$5.00 per late 4-H'er.

The late fee schedule will be as follows:

*The only exception to this policy is 4-H Horticulture, with the deadline for submitting forms being Friday, July 1, 2022.

June 15

- YQCA (certification completed and certificate copies submitted)
- Livestock Affidavits (make sure tag numbers on both affidavits and entry sheets match)
- Bucket Calf and Return Bucket Calf Record Books
- Vaccination Papers for Cats and Dogs
- Pre-Fair Entry Forms (exception Horticulture Entry Form)
- Clothing/Fashion Revue Paperwork and Narratives

July 1

- Horticulture Entry Form
