

PRE-ENTRY MUST BE MADE AT THE EXTENSION OFFICE BY JUNE 15, 2022.

Exhibitors must also enter the showmanship contest. The exhibitor may select the obedience class best suited for their dog, except dogs with AKC "Companion Dog" degree may not compete in the Beginning Novice obedience class. Females in season will not be permitted to show. No treats will be allowed in the show pen. Where the age permits all dogs must have been immunized against rabies, Distemper, Hepatitis, Coronavirus, and Parvo. Dog exhibitors must bring proof of vaccination. One of the following is required as proof of vaccination: Vet health certification form with a vet's signature, vaccination receipt or vaccinations printout. 4H'ers vaccinating their own dogs must provide proof in the form of a statement from their vet or by turning in the serum vile. If vaccinations are not current, animals will not be allowed to show. **Vaccinations must be completed by June 15, 2022, and turned into the office with pre-registration papers.**

This is an un-benched 4-H Dog Show and may not be consistent with all AKC rules. Use "Guidelines for Nebraska 4H Dog Shows" as an aid. Dogs will be brought to the fairgrounds prior to the show. Exhibits will be released at the conclusion of the show. 4-H STORY AND PICTURE OF ANIMAL MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY. THE POSTER WILL BE 14" X 22". THEY WILL BE LEFT ON DISPLAY AFTER JUDGING AND RELEASE OF ANIMALS. **Check in ½ hour prior to the show. Please see the fair schedule for show time.**

G 701 10 BEGINNING NOVICE DIVISION A Handler and the dog being shown are both in their first year of county, state 4H, or any other dog show experience. Dog being shown may not have completed an AKC "leg" toward a "CD" degree. Beginning dog or beginning handler may enter this class. All exercises must be performed on a 6-foot leash. Dogs must heel including figure 8; stand for examination; come on recall; long sit for one minute and long down for three minutes. During the sit and down exercise, the leash must be held by the handler.

G 701 20 BEGINNING NOVICE DIVISION B Beginning dogs with experienced handlers and dogs that have not earned a purple in Division A or B. Handlers may repeat this class until the dog has earned a purple ribbon or award.

G 701 25 BEGINNING NOVICE DIVISION C Exhibitor and dog are beyond first year of competition.

G 701 30 NOVICE A Dogs must heel on leash heel free including figure 8; stand for examination off leash; heel free; come on recall off leash; long sit for one minute off leash and long down for three minutes off leash with handler across the ring.

G 701 35 NOVICE B Exhibitor and dog are beyond first year of Novice competition.

G 701 40 GRADUATE NOVICE Dogs must heel on leash; stand for examination off lead, heel free including figure 8; drop on recall off leash; long sit off leash for 3 minutes and long down off leash for 5 minutes both with handler out of sight.

G 701 45 ADVANCED GRADUATE NOVICE Exhibitor and dog have received a purple in Graduate Novice. Dogs must heel on leash and figure 8 (off leash), drop on recall, dumbbell recall, recall over high jump, recall over broad jump, and long down.

G 701 50 OPEN All exercises off leash. Dogs must: heel free and figure 8; drop on recall; retrieve on flat; retrieve over high jump; broad jump; long sit for 3 minutes and long down for 5 minutes, both with handler out of sight. Refer to Guidelines for Nebraska 4H Dog Shows for jump heights/distances.

G 701 55 GRADUATE OPEN Exhibitor and dog have received a purple in Open. Includes - signal exercise, scent discrimination, directed retrieve, moving stand and examination, go out, and directed jumping.

G 701 60 UTILITY Exhibitor and dog have received a purple in Graduate Open. All exercises must be off leash. The dogs will perform five exercises; the signal exercise; the scent discrimination exercise with leather and metal objects; the directed retrieve; moving stand and examination' and directed jumping. Exhibitors must supply their own scent articles and gloves for the directed retrieve.
