If awarded a scholarship...

1. You will receive notification of award by April 4.
2. You will need to send a completed camp/workshop registration form to the Dodge County Extension office. The Dodge County 4-H Council will pay the award amount to the camp/workshop directly and forward the registration form. Additional camp/workshop fees are your responsibility to pay.
3. The Dodge County 4-H Council **requires** an oral or written summary of the 4-H member's camp/workshop experience, due by October 1, 2022.
4. A written thank you note to the Dodge County 4-H Council is requested from the 4-H members who are awarded scholarships.
5. Up to twelve \$25 scholarships will be awarded to Clover Kid members based on a lottery system. Clover Kids will only be required to fill out the first page of the application.
6. Up to seven \$100 scholarships will be awarded to 4-H members age 8 - 18 on January 1, 2022 based on the entire application. 4-H members age 8-18 by Jan. 1 will be required to complete both pages of the application, including the three essay questions.
