Bucket Calf Guidelines

FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Refer to the GENERAL & ANIMAL RULES AND REGULATIONS.

<u>ANIMAL IDENTIFICATION</u>: Exhibitors must exhibit bucket calves that have been identified under their name and are filed with the Extension Office by the set deadline. The ID's for all bucket calf entries will be checked by the superintendent when the animal is brought to Expo. Final decision as to the class in which an animal will be shown will rest with the superintendent.

ENTRY LIMIT: An exhibitor is limited to exhibiting ONE bucket calf.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Bucket calves are NOT eligible to show in the beef and/or dairy cattle show.
- The bucket calf show is open to youth ages 8 to 18 if the 4-H or FFA member is currently enrolled in the bucket calf project in their respective counties.
- Each exhibitor will be scheduled for a ten-minute interview.
- Exhibitors are asked to use their county's Bucket Calf Record Book. However, it should include at least one page that includes a story and no more than two pages of pictures.
- Ribbons will be awarded on the basis of total points from all three categories.
- Exhibitors must exhibit in official 4-H or FFA attire.
