- ✓ <u>ARRIVAL/CHECK-IN:</u> Plan to arrive, check in and be <u>set up no later than 11:15 a.m.</u> Please check-in at the Volunteer/Presenter Check-in that will be located in the Lobby of the Event Center. You may enter from the north or south or entrance of the building.
 - Some students could arrive as early as 8:30 a.m. There is a little bit of time that students could visit your booth before the welcome at 9:00 a.m. If you choose to set up in the morning, please do so before 8:30 a.m. and keep in mind that students will be listening to introductions and the key note speaker from 9:00-9:55 a.m. and then go directly to two career sessions with no opportunity to visit booths. They should be returning to the Event Center starting at 11:25 a.m.
- ✓ TAKE DOWN: The students will be at lunch and have the opportunity for booth visitation from 11:35 a.m.-12:05 p.m. They will travel to the enrichment sessions beginning at 12:05 p.m. You are welcome to take down your booth and leave at the time the students leave for their enrichment sessions. There will be no opportunity for booth visitation for the remainder of the day.

You are more than welcome to come early and listen to our keynote speaker, stay later for our cap note speaker and/or visit the career and enrichment sessions. For more details, refer to the schedule that is included below.

- ✓ <u>BOOTH LOCATION</u>: The booths will be located on the gym floor in the Midland University Event Center.
- ✓ <u>EQUIPMENT:</u> One table will be supply for your booth display.
