YQCA - Required for all Livestock Exhibitors by June 15

! Visit <u>yqcaprogram.org</u> to log in or register - the cost is \$12 paid online. Submit YQCA certificates to the office in person or by email by June 15 to qualify exhibitors to show at Fremont 4-H Expo, Dodge County Fair, or Nebraska State Fair!!

YQCA is an annual education and certification program focused on food safety, animal well-being and character awareness required for youth ages 8 to 21 who produce and/or show pigs, beef cattle, dairy cattle, sheep, goats, rabbits, and poultry.

State Fair Livestock ID & Nomination Deadline - June 15

! Any members planning to exhibit livestock at the Nebraska State Fair must complete the appropriate livestock identification and <u>nomination</u> requirements **by midnight**, **June 15**. This process makes an individual animal eligible for entry at the State Fair. Learn more at 4h.unl.edu/livestock-id.



Horse, Beef, Swine, Sheep, Goat, Dairy, Bucket Calf, Rabbit, Poultry, Dog, and Companion Animal entries are required to be made <u>by July 15.</u>

Static Exhibit Entry is optional online - complete by July 18 for the Extension Office to print your static entry tags. Entry tags will be available in the Extension Office and at check in during the fair.

Great Plains Livestock Judging Circuit

The Great Plains Livestock Judging Circuit is a lineup of contests held throughout the state giving youth the opportunity to perfect their skills in preparation for the Nebraska 4-H Premier Animal Science Event (PASE). Qualifying youth must attend a minimum of two contests in addition to the PASE livestock judging contest in



order to be eligible for awards and scholarships. The top 5 individuals in the Senior and Intermediate divisions will be recognized as part of the All-State Team during the Grand Drive at the Nebraska State Fair.
