Horse

General Information:

- The show will be conducted according to the Nebraska 4-H Horse Show and Judging Guide (4-H 373).
- **Horse Affidavits are due to either Extension office by May 7, 2021**
- **Horse Level Testing for the Sarpy County Fair must be completed with completion sheet signed and turned in to the 4-H Office by June 15th.**
- **Sarpy County Fair Entries are due via Showworks by July 15.**
- **All class entries are due on July 15th. There will be no additions to classes the day of the show, only scratches can be made.**
- Stalling during the fair is optional. Requests are also due by July 15th and are filled on a **First Come First Served** basis. Horses must be kept from Wednesday August 4, 2021 from 6 p.m. until Sunday August 8, 2021, at 6:30 a.m. or exhibitors and clubs can rotate their horses during that period. Stalls must be stripped of bedding by 7 p.m., Monday, August 9th, 2021.
- Horses can be out of stalls for exercise from 6 - 9 a.m. The arena may be used at the Sarpy County Fairboard's direction or horses may be exercised in the north parking lot of the fairgrounds.
- Horse check-in will begin at 7:00 a.m. Saturday, July 31st and 4:30 p.m. for speed classes.
- Shows will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and 5:00 p.m. for speed classes.
- Performance Show order on Saturday will be Halter, Showmanship, English Pleasure, English Equitation, Hunter Hack, Pony Pleasure, Western Pleasure, Ranch Pleasure Western Horsemanship, 2 and 3 yr. old Pleasure, Trail, Reining and Walk/Trot Speed (Poles, Barrels, Flag Race & Keyhole). All patterns will be provided to exhibitors and families during check in.
- The Saturday evening show order will be Pole Bending, Barrel Racing, Flag Race, Keyhole Race, and Stationary Roping.
- Exhibitors must have passed Level I to compete in riding classes. Level 2 is required for competing in Hunter Hack, Ranch Pleasure Ranch Riding disciplines.
- **Rules regarding proper attire and equipment will be strictly enforced. Rules for attire and equipment can be found in the Nebraska 4-H Horse Show and Judging Guide (4-H373)**
- **Age Divisions:**
 - Senior - 4- H age 15-18 years old.
 - Intermediate - 4-H age 12-14 years old.
 - Junior - 4-H age 8-11 years old.
 - Clover Kids are not allowed to show horses.
 - Special needs exhibits are considered youth ages 8 -21 years old on January 1 that are mentally and/or physically challenged.
- **If an exhibitor enters a Walk Trot class, they will not be allowed to enter a cantor riding class. Example: Cannot enter Walk Trot Pleasure, and also compete in Western Pleasure Junior**

- **Walk/Trot Speed Events will be held immediately after the Performance Show. Horses extending beyond a lope will be disqualified.**
- A High Point Exhibitor Award and Reserve High Point Award will be given in each age division for Performance and Speed Events
- High Point Performance Classes: Halter, Showmanship, English Pleasure, English Equitation, Pony Pleasure, Western Pleasure, Western Horsemanship, Trail & Reining
- High Point Speed Classes: Poles, Barrels, Keyhole, Flag Race, Stationary Roping.
- There is no limit on the number of classes an exhibitor or horse can enter except that a horse can only enter a class once. It can be entered in different age groups (Example: The same horse can enter both junior and senior barrel racing but can only be in junior barrel racing once.)
- The hippology contest will be held TBD. There will be first year, junior, senior, masters and adult with a written examination and identification stations.
- Exhibitor must receive a purple ribbon to receive an award, Champion, Reserve Champion or plaque.
- The scoring and ribbon placing by the judge is FINAL.
- **All classes are pay level 3. Club Herdsmanship is pay level 1.**
