Division 60-Horse

General Information:

- The show will be conducted according to the Nebraska 4-H Horse Show and Judging Guide (4-H 373).
- Rules regarding proper attire and equipment will be strictly enforced. Rules for attire and equipment can be found in the Nebraska 4-H Horse Show and Judging Guide (4-H373)
- Exhibitors must have passed Level I to compete in riding classes.

****In the event of rain, the shows will be moved to an alternative day/time. ****

Important Dates:

- County Fair and State Horse ID Sheets are due to Extension office by June 1st, 2023.
- Horse Level Testing for the Sarpy County Fair must be completed with the completion sheet signed and turned in to the 4-H Office by July 1st.
- Sarpy County Fair Entries are due via Showorks by July 15.
- All class entries are due on July 15th. There will be no additions to classes the day of the show, only scratches can be made.

Class Entries:

- There is no limit on the number of classes an exhibitor or horse can enter except that a horse can only enter a class once. It can be entered in different age groups.
 - (Example: The same horse can enter both junior and senior barrel racing but can only be in junior barrel racing once.)
- Exhibitor must receive a purple ribbon to receive an award, Champion, Reserve Champion or plaque.
- The scoring and ribbon placing by the judge is FINAL.
- All classes are pay level 3. Club Herdsmanship is pay level 1.
- Exhibitors entering in any Walk/Trot performance class MAY NOT enter into Non-Walk/Trot Speed Classes. Horses extending beyond a lope will be disqualified.
- Level 2 is required for competing in Hunter Hack, and the 2- & 3-Year-Old Pleasure Class.
 - Horses entering in the 2- & 3-Year-Old Pleasure Class must have a 2 & 3 Year Old Affidavit on file
 - o 3-Year-Old Pleasure Horses must compete as a 2-Year-Old the year previous.

County Fair Information:

- Stalling during the fair is optional. Requests are also due by July 15th and are filled on a **First Come First Served** basis. Horses must be kept from **Wednesday August 2, 2023** from 6 p.m. until Sunday **August 6, 2022, at 6:30 a.m.** or exhibitors and clubs can rotate their horses during that period. Stalls must be stripped of bedding by 7 p.m., **Monday, August 8th, 2023**.
 - Horses can be out of stalls for exercise from 6 9 a.m. The arena may be used at the Sarpy County Fairboard's direction or horses may be exercised in the north parking lot of the fairgrounds.

Age Divisions:

- Senior 4- H age 15-18 years old.
- Intermediate 4-H age 12-14 years old.
- Junior 4-H age 8-11 years old.
- Special needs exhibits are considered for youth ages 8 -21 years old on January 1 that are mentally and/or physically challenged.

Clover Kids are NOT allowed to show horses.
