

## Revisions for Judging Food Projects for 2020.

**Judging with exhibit only** (*no tasting of exhibits according to [NDA Guidelines](#) which would include the judging process and eliminates bake sales and cake auctions due to COVID-19, also talk with local health department*)

- To help eliminate food waste and financial cost to families, consider reducing the amount of the exhibit that the 4-H'er is required to bring:
  - Example: Bring only part of the product, example ½ of a loaf of bread
  - Example: Cookies, biscuits or anything that would be displayed with 4, bring 2
  - Picture or copy of the recipe and supporting information (refer to county fairbook to see if an exhibit requires supporting information)
  - Food can be displayed or discarded after judging.

Modified score sheets have been created by the state 4-H office that have eliminated the tasting criteria. All exhibits would use one of these four scoresheets:
