# A Bug's Life

## Fun facts

- Camouflaged when actively feeding
- A bag may have up to 1000 eggs
- Caterpillar disperse by wind
- Female bagworm spends entire life in the bag
- 1 generation per year: Injury June through August

## Identification

<u>Caterpillar</u>: Covered in plant material with head and thoracic legs visible when feeding

<u>Moth</u>: Female is wingless, male is furry, gray moth

#### **Host plants**

• Various, but can cause death to evergreens

Bagworm Thyridopteryx ephemeraeformis

### Management

- Handpick before end of Oct to May
- Insecticide treatment in June when caterpillars are young
