### Hay Donations - Large Bales Only

Large round and square hay donations will be collected approximately ½ mi. west of the intersection of County Road 10 (blacktop road that goes south out of Mead, NE) and County Road H.

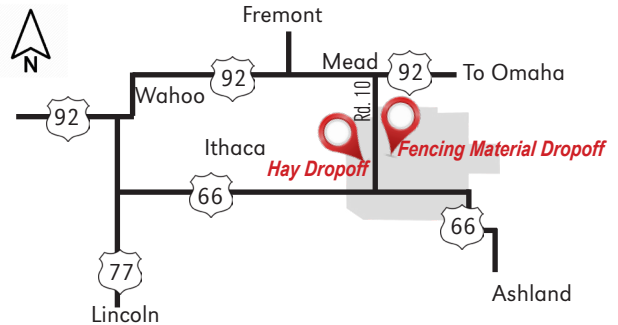
Enter from the EAST and exit to the WEST.

**Small bales should be taken to the Lancaster Event Center in Lincoln.**

**From Mead:** 5 mi. South and ½ mi. West on Rd. H

**From Hwy 66/Rd. 10:** 1 mi. North and ½ mi. West on Rd. H

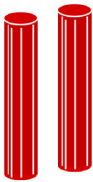

**From Omaha:** PLEASE NOTE SOME ROADS OUT OF OMAHA ARE CLOSED DUE TO FLOOD DAMAGE - review [511.nebraska.gov](http://511.nebraska.gov) map for closures and follow detour routes. From the west side of Omaha, Take 204th Street (Hwy. 6) – go south to Interstate 80. Go west on Interstate 80 and take Mahoney State Park Exit (Exit 426) this will take you to Hwy. 66. Go through Ashland and stay on Hwy. 66. Follow Hwy. 66 to Road 10. Turn north (right) onto Road 10 and follow directions for Hay or Fencing Materials locations.

**From Lincoln:** Take Hwy. 77 north out of Lincoln towards Wahoo. Just north of the unincorporated community of Swedeburg (and 4 miles south of Wahoo), you will approach a green Univ. of Nebraska Agricultural R & D Center sign, a Hwy. 66/77 sign, and a Wahoo/Ashland/Ithaca sign. Turn east (right) onto Hwy. 66 (formerly Hwy. 63) and travel 7 miles east, follow directions for Hay or Fencing Materials locations.



### Feed and Fencing Materials Donations

Fencing materials donations and feeding supplies will be collected at a designated location at the ENREC Farm and Facilities Operations Shop.

Coordinates are: [41.176711 -96.469526](#). Follow redwood directional signs off County Road 10 (blacktop road that goes south out of Mead, NE) and County Road J. Look for the redwood “Farm Operations” sign.

**From Mead:** 4 mi. South and ½ mi. East on Rd. I

**From Hwy 66/Rd. 10:** 1 ¾ mi. North and ½ mi. East on Rd. I
