## 4-H Crops - Youth & STEM

Promotion for the
Innovative Youth Corn Challenge
began, including an interview on
Pure Nebraska. One youth from
the winning team was able to talk
about his team's project. I worked
with John Thomas, cropping
systems educator located in the
Panhandle on the special
agronomy project. He peerreviewed the newsletter I created,
provided fun activities for youth to
complete and found a source for
the seed. Regional youth crop
scouting competition coordinators



met to start planning for the 2024 programming.

In collaboration with Iowa State Extension, we presented on our North Central Integrated Pest Management grant programming on pollinators at the **Nebraska** 

Association for Conservation & Environmental Education conference. Fifteen formal and informal educators from Nebraska participated in our hands-on workshop with positive feedback received regarding the curriculum we packaged.



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### 4-H Youth Development



Locally, I organized the **Ag Safety Day** planning to prepare for the 2024 event which will be held in May; inviting speakers and preparing has begun. I assisted with the Fillmore Central ninth grade **Reality Fair**. I helped answer questions to youth regarding college funding and loans with the simulation. As a member of the **Nebraska 4-H Section** diversity

committee, I created an online newsletter to membership with tips on reaching all.

I taught 13 Clay County Clover Kids

during a Clover Kid workshop. Youth created "snowy owls" using pinecones and cotton while parents learned more about the 4-H enrollment process and created snacks for their youth out of a 4-H manual with Holli.

I tested and finished writing the plant science biotechnology lesson for ROOTED in Ag. In addition, I had the opportunity to pilot the electrophoreses experiment with 80 high school youth at a Science Fair in Hastings. Youth said they enjoyed the experiment and have never done anything with electrophoreses. I also taught 30 junior high youth about variable rate engineering, and they engineered their own variable rate pivot irrigation systems.
