School Enrichment-

In March the Exeter-Milligan 6th grade participated in a seven-week adventure into College and Career Readiness. As a group every Tuesday we discussed topics like setting goals, career clusters, and college terminology.

The mobile beef lab team traveled to the Zoetis LPS science fair in Lincoln. We used the fistulae steer to teach hundreds of youth about ruminant digestion and how awesome it is that cattle can turn grass into beef.

As our new normal quickly changed with online learning, so did the way extension and 4-H started teaching lessons. I was asked by the 4-H assistant in York county to assist her with a series of lessons she started called Beef Detectives.
