Professional Development-

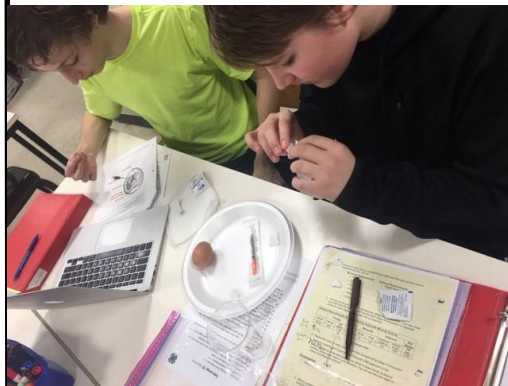
The beginning of January we participated in the Library Innovation Studio Training. At the Geneva Library 15 pieces of equipment/kits have moved in. we were trained on how to use the equipment properly. School Enrichment-

Embryology kick off for the year at the Fillmore Central High School with Mr. VanDeWalle Animal Science class. Twelve youth learned basic terms and conditions chicken eggs need to be at in order to hatch.



Then youth learned how to candle eggs. Also they dyed embryos and learned why researchers might do this. Last we talked about the chicken digestive system.
