April 1st - 12th, 2024

Youth <u>MUST</u> be enrolled in 4-H and pay the shooting sports registration fee before the **first practice**. Youth will NOT be allowed to participate in shooting sports until enrollment and payment are received.

- 1. Enroll in 4-H at v2.4honline.com and pay county dues PRIOR to the mandatory meeting on April 14th.
- 2. Complete the Frontier County 4-H Shooting Sports Enrollment form. This is available at https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/frontier/shooting-sports/ or pick up a hard copy at the office.
- 3. Return all paper work and fees by April 12th to the Extension Office or bring to the mandatory meeting April 14th.

2024 Frontier County Sharp Shooters 4-H Club Shooting Practice Schedule

Need to attend AT LEAST 4 practices in EACH discipline area to be able to compete in county contest. The mandatory club meeting itself does NOT count as a practice. Weather permitting, practice before or after the meeting will count as one practice. Plan now to ensure eligibility!

**4-H Archery, BB Gun, Air Pistol, Air Rifle, .22 Caliber Small Bore Rifle, Pistol and Shotgun

All Sunday practices start at 4:00 pm, Wednesday practices start at 7:00 pm at the Frontier County Fairgrounds in Stockville - April 14, 21; May 5, 15, 19, 22; June 2, 12, 16, 26, 30; July 7, 14. **Contest will be held on Saturday, July 20th.**

*Curtis Shotgun - All practices will be held at the Curtis Gun Club on Tuesdays beginning at 6:30 pm - May 7, 14, 21, 28; June 4, 11, 18, 25; July 2 - Shotgun Contest will be held at the Curtis Gun Club on July 16th, 2024

Youth will NOT be eligible for a ribbon if unable to participate the day of contest.
