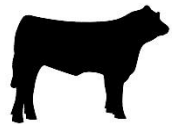


FAMILY CONSUMER SCIENCE

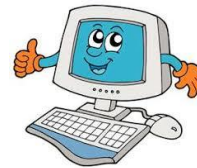
PLANTS & BUGS
