County Fairs Ready? - The Wild West 4-H Livestock Club is having a supper for the livestock buyers. Ashley Benes and Chuck Burr will both be at Stockville helping with the fair. Summer 4-H intern Micky Blender will be the Nebraska Extension person at Eustis Fair & Corn Show.

Proposal For Grant Money-Riding on Faith Horse Club - There was discussion about the kit being not as high quality as what it is worth. We considered to help them find some other type of learning kit. Stephanie moved to donate \$50 to the Riding on Faith Horse Club and to help laminating if they found materials that needed to be.

State Fair - Kathy reminded us when entries were due for State Fair, which is August 10th, online. Kathy also gave us a heads-up that the State Fair discount tickets for 4-H families are not available at the county offices. People must order directly from statefair.org.

\$5.00 Volunteer Screening - Kathy discussed the \$5 screening that needs to be taken if you are a volunteer that works with 4-Hers. It was debated if the volunteers should pay for their screening, or if the council should pay for the volunteer screening. Stephanie moved for the council to pay for the \$5 screening fee. Harris seconded, motion passed.

Council Financial Record Keeping - Stephanie moved to table till the next meeting. Donald seconded, motion passed.

County Wide Fun Event? - Was decided to table to the next meeting.
