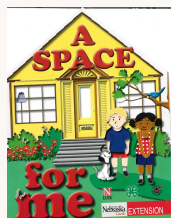

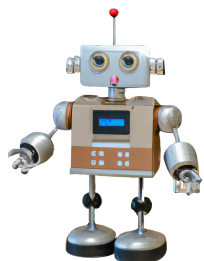
Nebraska 4-H STEM Reading Connection

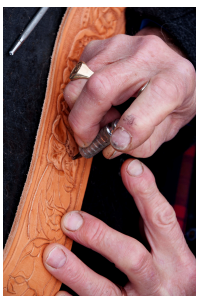
Any youth ages 8-14 (2 age tracts) are invited to participate in a hands-on day camp, exploring fun STEM and topics as they relate to Nebraska's leading industry-agriculture!

Participants will rotate through 4 different sessions. Session include:

- Desktop Greenhouses - Investigate the importance of light to plants by creating a desktop greenhouse investigation and exploring the process of photosynthesis.
- Engineering Ice Cream - Explore the journey of milk from cow to ice cream and make your own ice cream in a bag!
- Think your Drink - Discover the amount of sugar in our common drinks
- Every Tree for Itself! - Learn the needs of trees and how to ID them by exploring their leaves.
