

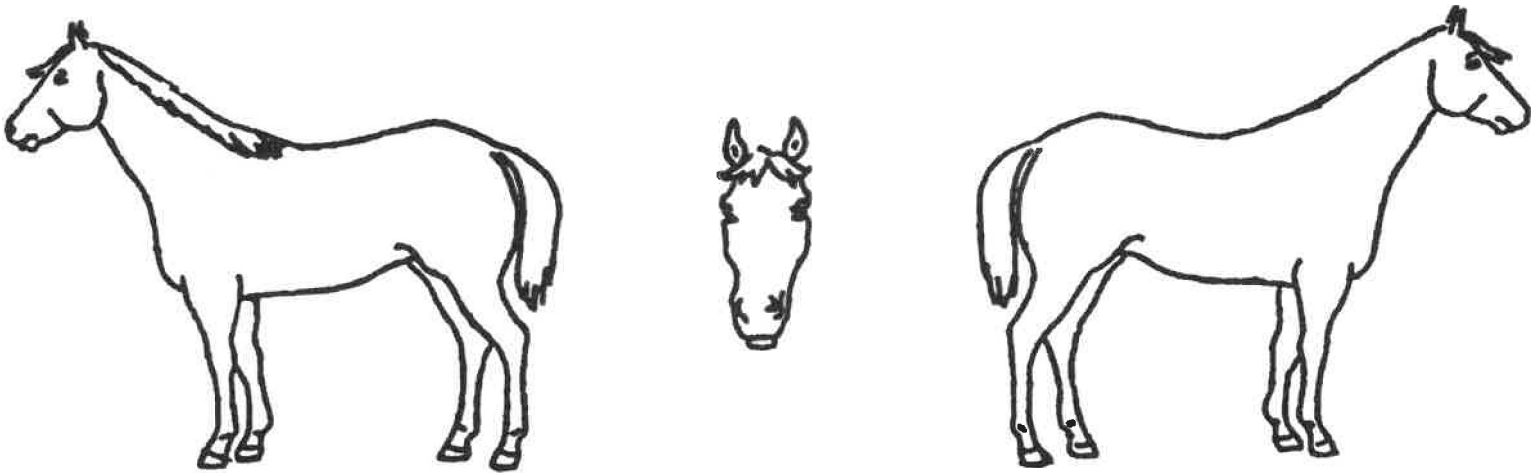

County Horse Show: Thursday, July 25; Friday, July 26

Enter online at gage.fairwire.com by July 15. Exhibitors must complete Level I before July 15 to enter in any pleasure or horsemanship/equitation classes at the Gage County Fair Horse Show (more details outlined in the Fairbook). First year 4-H members will be given until the beginning of their second year to complete Level I.
