Career Day is fast approaching and we are excited to host the 2023 Northeast Nebraska Sophomore Career Day. Please read this communiqué completely. It is packed with information to help you and your students have a great day.

Student Session Assignment Spreadsheets:

- This was emailed to you in August. **You will be receiving a final listing to check over later this week.** Please notify Mary Jarvi (mary.jarvi@unl.edu) if you see something that needs corrected right away. **Due to presenter schedules, you may notice a change in some student schedules on your final listing.**

Counselor/Sponsor Responsibilities:

- Print information for your students
- Prepare students for appropriate interaction with presenters
- Notify us of any changes prior to the event. It is easier to handle before than the day of the event.
- Be available to assist your students during and between sessions.
- Supervise breakout sessions and lunch – helping youth through the process and keeping on schedule ***You will be notified of the breakout sessions you are being assigned to help supervise a week before.***
- **Inform students about where to meet at the end of the day.**

Evaluations:

- Evaluations will be submitted on-line after Career Day, please make sure all students complete them.

Parking:

- A parking pass for Lot 10 is located on the web page for those of you who are driving vans or cars. Please leave the parking pass on the dash of your vehicle.
- **Buses do not need a permit, but will also park in Lot 10 after dropping students off in Rec Center parking lot in the morning.**

Packets/folders:

- Upon arrival in Rice Auditorium, we will have school packets for each school. School packets will include pencils and folders for each student.
 - Name tag to be worn on upper right hand shoulder of shirt. Name tags will have student schedule with room and building for their sessions on.
- Student folders will include:
 - Campus Map.
 - Program including a schedule
 - Handouts from WSC, UNL, NECC, and AHEC.

Cell Phones:

- **We ask that students not bring or use cell phones during Career Day.**
 - Instructors may collect phones used during their session if necessary.
- In an emergency, phones will be available in the buildings or with Career Day staff.

Lunch: (Student Center)

- Lunch is offered at three times, (sessions 2, 3, & 4). Student's lunch assignment is located on their name tag. All students in the Medical Career Tracks will eat lunch during the 4th session.
- Students with cafeteria lunch tickets will eat in the Student Center cafeteria which is located on the second floor. **Tickets will be collected** at the door.
- Students bringing sack lunches will eat in the lower level of the Student Center or outside on the south side of the Student Center weather permitting.
