



2024 CHECKLIST FOR LIVESTOCK FAMILIES

- Re-enroll in 4-H** at v2.4honline.com by **March 15th**.
(New members must enroll by **June 15th**, in order to participate in County or State Fair.)
- Pay your 4-H dues** of **\$10** per 4-H member, either online while enrolling or at the office.
- County Fair: Turn in ID sheets for ALL ANIMALS** to the Extension office by **June 14th**.
(ID sheets can be found on our website: hall.unl.edu/hall-county-fair-information) or at the Extension Office. If you weighed in market beef on 1/6/24 or market sheep/goats in May TBD, we already have ID sheets for those animals.)
- State Fair: Enter information online at showstockmgr.com** for any market or breeding animal (or feeder calf) that you are considering taking to State Fair. **DNA envelopes** must be turned in at the Extension Office for ALL animals that you are considering taking to State Fair. Deadline is **June 14th**. (If you weighed animals in another county but intend to show them in Hall County, make sure to get the ID sheets/DNA to the Hall County Extension Office ASAP.)
- Complete Quality Assurance** and turn in certificates by **June 14th**. Access the YQCA course at yqcaprogram.org. (4-H'ers must be enrolled in 4-H Online before completing QA.) *Includes ALL EXHIBITORS (4-H age 8-18) showing beef, sheep, goats, swine, dairy cattle, poultry & rabbits*
- Turn in your Hall County Fair entry form**, which tells the office EVERYTHING (including specific animals with tag #s) you are bringing to fair by **June 24th**. *Forms will be emailed around June 1; please watch for them.*
