

TIPS FOR COMPLETING YOUR 4-H ENROLLMENT

- ✓ Nebraska 4-H has transitioned to 4-H Online 2.0. To enroll, visit: <https://v2.4honline.com/>. For returning families, please do not create a new account; use your log-in credentials for 4-H Online used in previous years. - ✓ Families may enroll in Hall County 4-H at any time throughout the year. However, in order to be eligible to participate in the Hall County Fair (or any pre-fair activities), enrollment must be completed by June 15 (or before the pre-fair activity in which you plan to participate).
- ✓ Please review ALL data listed in your 4-H Online profile and edit any outdated information. Information such as phone number, address, etc. is very important and should be kept up to date.
- ✓ The health information is optional, however we highly recommend completing the health form.
- ✓ Club Enrollment - You may enroll in more than one club, however please enroll only in clubs where you intend on being an active member. Contact the club leader to verify that they are taking new members & to find out dates & location of meetings.
- ✓ Projects - Add all the projects the 4-H member is considering for County Fair. You may continue to add or change projects in 4-H Online until June 15 of the current year. Remember, if you are not enrolled in the project, you may not receive special notices about that project. - ✓ On the invoice and payment page, be sure to add your credit card information if that is your preferred method of payment (we are unable to process CC payments at the Extension office).
