



HALL COUNTY FAIR CHECKLIST

Attached are separate entry forms for Large Animals, Small Animals, Horses, Clothing Construction & Static Exhibits. Please refer to the 2024 Hall County Fair Premium Book, containing 4-H project class descriptions, when filling out entry forms. The premium book is located at <https://hall.unl.edu/hall-county-fair/>.

- 4-H Dues Paid (\$10 per youth)
- Submitted animal ID/vaccination forms (ALL animals by June 14). *All forms can be found on the above website. ALL animals need a form completed except poultry & other pet or small animal.
- Completed Quality Assurance (turn in Certificates to Extension office by June 14) - Quality Assurance is REQUIRED for all youth (ages 8-18) who plan to show beef, swine, sheep, meat goats, dairy goats, dairy cattle, poultry and/or rabbits.
- Reviewed the 2024 Fair Premium Book (see above website)
- Submitted Hall County Fair Entry forms (see Late Entry Policy below)
- Submitted Online ID nominations and DNA by June 14 (if considering showing livestock at State Fair)
- Pick up livestock sale cards to distribute to potential buyers (if participating in the Market Livestock Auction)

Entry forms are due to the Extension office by Monday, June 24th!

- All entry forms, ID/vaccinations forms & Quality Assurance certificates can be scanned & emailed to cbeissenherz2@unl.edu or you may drop them off at the Extension Office.

NOTE: The Fair entry forms are pdf fillable, but you must follow this process to submit fillable forms: 1) Open the form & save the blank form to your computer/electronic device, 2) Fill out the appropriate sections of the form, then save changes to your device, 3) Close the form, 4) Create a new email message, attach the saved form, and send the email to cbeissenherz2@unl.edu.

Late Fair Entry Policy

A \$15 late fee will be charged per 4-H member, for any fair entry form received up to 2 business days after the deadline. Entries will not be accepted after that time. Late fees must be paid at the time that the late entries are turned in.

When are fair entries due? **Monday, June 24th by 5:00 pm.** Entries must be complete with all proper documentation to be considered on time.

Entries received by the deadline (June 24th), but missing documentation (i.e. missing vaccinations, ID's and Quality Assurance not complete), will be considered late entries, and families will be required to pay the late fee. Missing documentation must be received within two business days of the entry deadline.
