Background

The Hall County 4-H Council will be sponsoring multiple scholarships each year for post-secondary education.

Who may apply

All 4-H members wanting to pursue a higher education. They must be enrolled in the Hall County 4-H program and apply during their senior year.

When to apply

Hall County applications are due to the Hall County Extension Office by **March 1st**.

Scholarship Selection

A 4-H Council Scholarship committee will make the selection of the scholarship winners. The basis of selection will be on 4-H, scholastic, and community involvement.

Conditions of Acceptance

Scholarship candidate may enroll in the school of their choice. Candidate is to inform the county Extension Office by **June 1st** if he/she does not plan to enroll in school. The scholarship will be sent to the appropriate college/university once proof of enrollment for the first semester is provided to the Extension Office.
