



## PROJECT KINDNESS SPINNERS

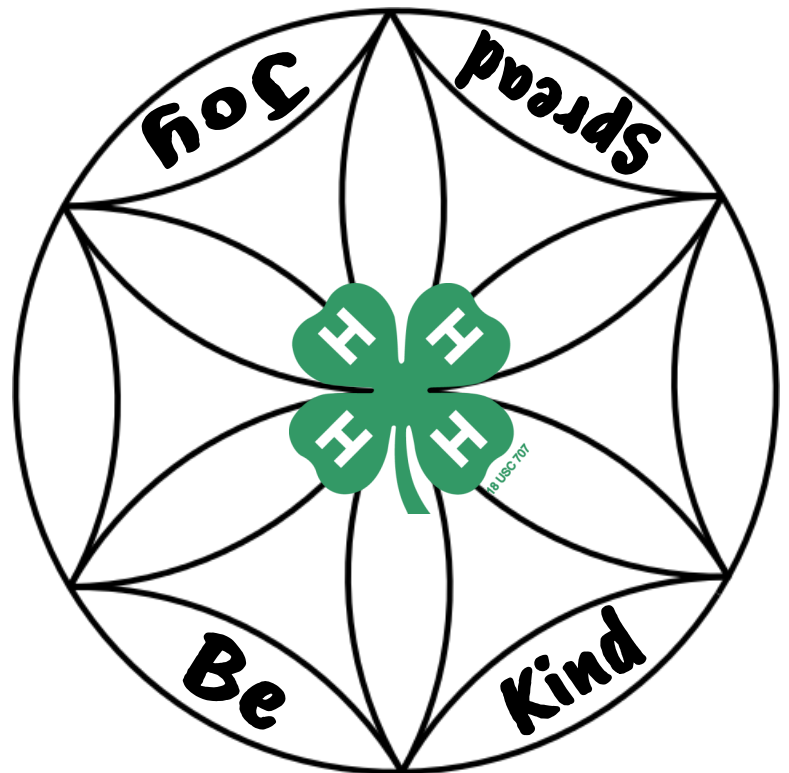
Make kindness a habit with Project Kindness Spinners! Kindness can make a difference in your life and others.

**Supplies:** Cereal box, a 4-inch diameter circular object to trace (bowl or lid), pennies, markers, crayons or colored pencils, glue, scissors, and a printer (optional).

**Instructions:**

1. Using the cardboard from a cereal box, cut out a 4-inch circle.
2. Print off the designs. Then color and cut out your design. Glue the design to the top of the cardboard circle.
3. If you are not using a printer, create/color your own design on the cardboard.
4. Cut a small slit in the middle, being careful not to cut the slit larger than the penny. (Adult help may be needed.)
5. Insert a penny into the slit and spin your Kindness Spinner!
