2024 4-H State Fair Livestock Exhibitor Checklist

- o Enroll in 4-H.
- Review the 4-H animal fairbooks and identification requirements.
 - Every animal nomination (this includes all breeding animals and feeder calves) will require a DNA submission.
 - Any animal carrying an 840 EID tag will require the exhibitor to have a premises ID for that animal's location.
- Ask the Extension office for official DNA envelopes or attend a tagging/weigh-in date at your county to have DNA pulled.
- Go to <u>Show Stock Manager</u> and complete the online form for each livestock nomination.
 - Input the full identification number for the 840 EID tag or scrapie tag.
 - o For breeding livestock; input DOB, breed and registration number.
 - Do not forget to click the box "State Fair Nomination".
- Submit payment in Show Stock Manager.
 - Ensure that your amount paid matches how many you intended to nominate.
 - Each nomination will be \$7.00.
- Turn in your signed and sealed DNA envelopes with hair samples to the Extension office.
 - o Tip: Take a picture of your envelope for your records.
 - Ensure all youth sign and print their name(s).
- o Complete your online entry for State Fair.
 - Opening date: July 1
 - o Closing date: August 10, 8 PM CT
- Additional Reminders:
 - o Complete your YQCA program.
 - Communicate any lost tags to your local Extension office. They will assist you with the retag process.
 - Double check the tattoo or tag listed on your nomination matches what you submitted online and is legible.
 - For exhibitors with registered breeding livestock, the registration papers must show the exhibitor's name or a co-owner who is an immediate member of the exhibitor's family and is listed with the online nomination in Show Stock Manager.
