4-H Members and Leaders will enroll in clubs and projects through 4H Online at: v2.4honline.com Each member or volunteer must re-enroll in 4-H each year. Links are below.

Returning 4-H Members DO NOT set up a profile. You already have an account. Your login is your email address. If you have forgotten or do not know your password, please select "I forgot my password". A temporary password will be sent via email.

You are required to re-enroll for the 2021-2022 4-H year. Profile information may have changed so it is important that everyone (youth and volunteers) update their profile before submitting. Please be sure to double check your address, phone number, and email address and update if needed.

Remember that there should only be one 4hOnline profile per family.

Nebraska 4-H Foundation Scholarships

The Nebraska 4-H Foundation offers 4-H members the opportunity to apply for scholarships. The Nebraska 4-H Foundation awards up to \$22,000 worth of scholarships each year to 4-H'ers from across the state.

To apply for scholarships, 4-H'ers must submit the [Nebraska 4-H Achievement Application](#) for state-level review by **January 15th**. Youth must follow the application instructions available on the [Nebraska 4-H Achievement Application webpage](#). If applying for multiple scholarships, only one Achievement Application should be submitted. An applicant must select the scholarship to which he/she feels qualified.

4-H youth may want to visit with the Extension Office in their county and the financial aid office at the college of their choice. There may be other grants, scholarships, or low-interest loans for which they may be eligible.

Scholarship availability may change at any time without prior notice.
