Instructions to sign up

1. Go to <https://yqcaprogram.org>
2. Sign in or register new account
3. Scroll down and find the age of the youth taking the YQCA training.
4. Select Web-based training to sign up for the online YQCA training.
5. Select Instructor-Led Training for the in person YQCA training.
6. Select state—Nebraska
7. Verify your total is correct (\$12 web based training or \$3 instructor led training)
8. Enter card number, expiration date, and cvc number, and click pay.
