POULTRY UPDATE

The Nebraska Department of Agriculture (NDA) announced an order cancelling all poultry events across Nebraska due to highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI). The order prohibits birds of any type at events including but not limited to fairs, expositions, swap meets, exotic sales and live bird auctions. The order is effective immediately and will be in effect **until** May 15th, at which time the order will be reevaluated. The 4-H Team is closely following this evolving situation and will keep you updated with the situation.
