

#### VEGETABLES

#### Premium \$3.00 - \$2.00 - \$1.00

The stems of potatoes, carrots, and beets should be cut back to one inch in length. Side roots should be carefully removed so that the skin of the vegetables is not stuffed or broken. Onion stems should be cut back to one inch in length. The roots are to be rubbed off the base of the bulb. Some of the papery skin around the bulb may be carefully removed, but at least one should be left covering the onion bulb. Stems help keep produce fresher for judging and viewing.

PLEASE NOTE - With the early date of the fair and most vegetables are not at the maturity stage, entries will be allowed in the earlier stage of maturity and will be judged separately from the ripe vegetables.
