FRANKLIN COUNTY CONTESTS

PUBLIC SPEAKING

- Practice communication skills by writing a speech or public service Announcement.
- Franklin County Speech Contest is held in the spring. Watch your 4-H Newsletter for dates and contest entry information.

LIVESTOCK JUDGING

- Acquire a better knowledge of livestock and develop skill in selecting good livestock.
- Learn to identify breeds and classes of livestock.
- Help improve livestock on the farm and learn how to make individual decisions and support them with oral statements.
- Local contest is the South Central Nebraska Livestock Judging Clinic and Contest held in Bladen in May/June.

FAVORITE FOOD FAIR

- Choose a theme and design a table setting. Create a menu including your favorite food, prepared and ready to serve.
- Participate as individuals or teams of two.
- Franklin County Favorite Food Fair is held in the days leading up to County Fair.

PRESENTATIONS

- Prepare oral communications and gain poise while speaking. Practice communication skills by writing a speech or public service announcement.
- Franklin County Presentations Contest is held in the days leading up to county Fair.



STATE CONTESTS

CULINARY CHALLENGE

- Youth will create a menu, prepare one food item, and choose an appropriate theme for their occasion while expressing their food, nutrition, and food safety knowledge during a live interview with a judge.
- A team will consist of two members to be eligible to compete.
- Contest is held during the Nebraska State Fair.

DOG SKILLATHON

- This contest will provide 4-H participants an opportunity to test their knowledge of dogs.
- There will be a variety of stations with visual diagrams and hands-on activities that contestants will work through and be judged upon.
- This contest is held in conjunction with the State 4-H Dog Show.

4-H FILMFEST – DIGITAL VIDEO

- Digital videos submitted will be judged live at the 4-H FilmFest.
- Judge will view the video and engage in a question-and-answer session with the video producer(s).
- Digital videos may be created by one individual or a team of two.
- Contest is held during the Nebraska State Fair.

INSECT IDENTIFICATION

- Identify over 50 specimens.
- Learn about anatomy, kind of metamorphosis, habitat, or meanings of order names.
- Youth can participate as individuals or teams.
- Contest is held during the Nebraska State Fair.

LIFE CHALLENGES

- Learn about issues related to family and consumer science, explore career opportunities that are available, compete with other teams from across the state, and have fun.
- Opportunities include the Foods & Nutrition Challenge, Human Development Challenge, Design Challenge, and Entrepreneurship Investigation Challenge.
- Held in conjunction with PASE, this two-day late June event takes place in Lincoln

PREMIER ANIMAL SCIENCE EVENTS

- Learn about issues related to the animal industry and explore animal science careers.
- Opportunities include livestock, meats and poultry judging contests, livestock skill-a-thon, and a livestock quiz bowl.
- PASE Contest includes identification, judging contests and a livestock quizbowl.
- Held in conjunction with Life Challenges, this two-day late June event takes place in Lincoln.

TREE IDENTIFICATION

- Contest is held during the Nebraska State Fair.
