



2021 County Fair Horse Show Information

The 4-H Horse Superintendents met and assigned the official patterns and trail class for the Fair. **The 2021 4-H/FFA Horse Show will start at 8:30 a.m. on Wednesday, August 11.**

Reining Patterns:

Novice & Juniors - Pattern 1

Seniors - Pattern 2

Ranch Riding Class - Pattern 1

Trail Class – Novice, Juniors & Seniors:

1. opening, passing through, and closing gate
2. ride over wooden bridge
3. a. (seniors) lope over 4 logs 6-7 feet apart
b. (juniors & novice) walk over 4 logs 15-24 inches apart
4. drag an object backward and pull it forward with rope on saddle horn
5. take slicker off fence, drape over the horse and put back on the fence
6. a. (seniors & juniors) sidepass to mailbox/open, retrieve object from mailbox, place back in mailbox and close
b. (novice) open, retrieve object from mailbox, place back in mailbox and close

■ Before the Horse Show starts, there will be a **mandatory** meeting for horse exhibitors at 8:15 a.m. by the office

■ **Show Order** - Senior, Junior, Novice, FFA

■ After showmanship classes - arena is open for all exhibitors to warm-up their horses.

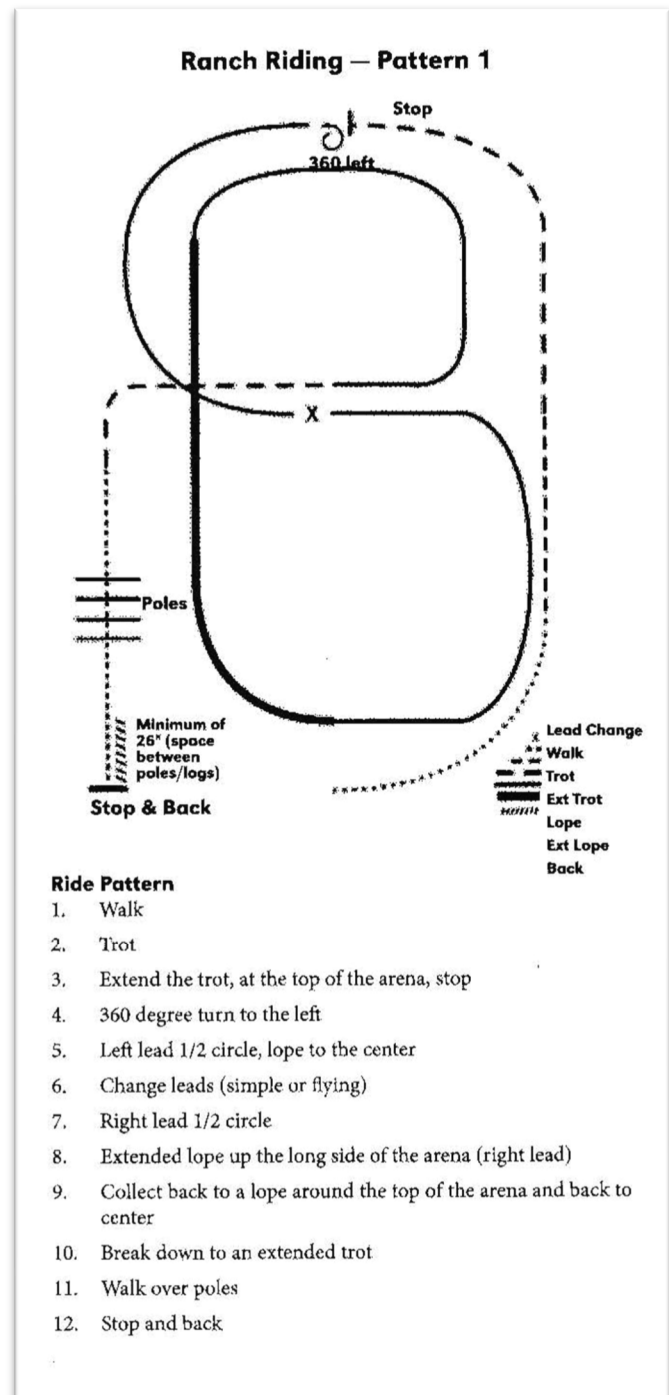
■ Any new ponies will need to be officially measured prior to show starting.

■ To receive a trophy, the exhibitor must have received a purple ribbon. (see page 13 of the fairbook)

■ Must be present to get ribbon. Ribbons will be handed out in the arena.

■ **No additions** on entry day.

■ **Scratches:** All 4-H members are encouraged to scratch one event prior to their class or as soon as possible. **Once they have scratched from a class, they cannot re-enter.**



Ride Pattern

1. Walk
2. Trot
3. Extend the trot, at the top of the arena, stop
4. 360 degree turn to the left
5. Left lead 1/2 circle, lope to the center
6. Change leads (simple or flying)
7. Right lead 1/2 circle
8. Extended lope up the long side of the arena (right lead)
9. Collect back to a lope around the top of the arena and back to center
10. Break down to an extended trot
11. Walk over poles
12. Stop and back
