**Clothing & Textiles Construction Judging** – All sewing & textiles projects must be entered on Thursday, August 5 for judging. There will be no judging of these projects done at the fair. All projects will be kept at the Extension Office and brought back to the fair on Wednesday, August 11 by the Extension Staff to receive ribbons and premiums for clothing/textile construction. **Fashion Show** – Each exhibitor is eligible to model five different outfits, each from a separate project (STEAM Clothing Construction (2 garments); STEAM Beyond the Needle; Shopping In Style; and \$15 Shopping Challenge). **Garments should be age appropriate. Nightshirt/loungewear, for example, flannel lounging pants will be allowed for County Fair, but are not eligible for State Fair.** Fashion Show Classes Include (pages 64-66 of fairbook):

- Modeled Constructed Sewing for Fun (carry or wear a project item)
- Modeled Constructed STEAM Clothing 1 Garment(s)
- Modeled Constructed STEAM Clothing 2 Garment(s)
- Modeled Constructed STEAM Clothing 3 Garment(s)
- Modeled Knitted or Crocheted Clothing (Level 2 or 3)
- Modeled STEAM Beyond The Needle Garment(s)
- Modeled Constructed Upcycled, Make-One/Buy-One & Quilt Quest Wearable Art Garment(s) – must be enrolled in STEAM Clothing Level 1, 2 or 3 or Quilt Quest to model in this class. The exhibit is a purchased garment with a constructed/upcycled garment(s) to make a complete wearable outfit. Both items must be modeled. **Not eligible for State Fair.**
