Shopping In Style Fashion Show - Everyone loves to shop! Go shopping and purchase an outfit to model in the Shopping In Style Fashion Show. You can purchase an outfit for a special occasion or an outfit to expand your current wardrobe. **The Shopping In Style Fashion Show is open to all 4-H members that are enrolled in either the Attention Shoppers (age 8) or the Shopping In Style (ages 9 & over) 4-H Project.** Judging will be on the written report, interview and modeling. **No notebook is required.** Participants must purchase and model a complete outfit. All pieces of the garment must be purchased. Make-One/Buy One outfits are not allowed. See page 71 of the fairbook for complete information. Classes Include:

- Model Purchased Outfit and Written Report (ages 8-9 on Jan 1)
- Model Purchased Outfit and Written Report (ages 10-12 on Jan 1)
- Model Purchased Outfit and Written Report (ages 13 & Over on Jan 1)

\$15 Shopping Challenge Fashion Show is open to all 4-H members. Participants are limited to one entry and are allowed to model in both the Shopping In Style and the \$15 Challenge. All pieces of the garment must be purchased from a garage sale, thrift store, consignment store or resale shop. Cost of the outfit must be \$15.00 or less (the \$15 does not include shoes & accessories). See page 71 of the fairbook for complete information. Classes include:

All projects will need to be kept at the Extension Office and brought back to the fair on Wednesday, August 9 by Extension Staff to receive ribbons and premiums.
