<u>Prepared Speech</u> - provides youth the opportunity to write and prepare a speech on a topic related to their 4-H experience. The judge will view the speech and evaluate based on the subject, organization, and delivery of the speech. All speeches must be original and include 4-H as the major component. The use of visual aids and props is not allowed.

Radio Public Service Announcement (PSA) - contest challenges youth to write and record a 60-second promotional audio recording focused on a yearly theme that could be played on the radio to promote the work of Nebraska 4-H. Youth are judged on their overall organization and delivery of the PSA. Entries must be submitted electronically in a .war or .mp3 audio format.

• 2024 Theme is "4-H is a Feeling". All 4-H PSA's must include the following tagline within the last 10 seconds of the PSA: "Learn more about the Nebraska Extension 4-H Youth Development Program at 4h.unl.edu."

NEW for 2024 - <u>4-H Impromptu Speech</u> — The Impromptu Speech competition gives youth the opportunity to write and present a speech around a 4-H related topic that they select during the competition where they are given 15 minutes to develop and prepare their presentation. The Judge will evaluate the subject, organization, and delivery of the speech.

NEW for 2024 – <u>Video Communication</u> – A video communication contest allows youth to create a multi-media video around a theme related to 4-H. The Judge will be evaluating both the organization of information as well as the audio and video production.

<u>4-H Illustrated Presentations</u> - is a live presentation with a formal talk where youth will use visual aids (such as props, posters, computer-based visuals, handouts, video, etc.) to show and tell others how to do something. The judge views the entire presentation and engages in a question-and-answer session following the presentation.

Age Divisions and Time Guidelines for Each Contest

Clover Kids	5-7	Speech - Under 1 minute Presentation – 1-3 minutes
Junior	8-10	Speech - 2 to 3 minutes PSA - 60 seconds Impromptu Speech - 1 ½ minutes Video Communication - 60 to 90 seconds Presentation - Individual 3-5 minutes or Team 5-7 minutes
Intermediate	11-13	Speech - 3 to 5 minutes PSA - 60 seconds Impromptu Speech - 3 minutes Video Communication - 60 to 90 seconds Presentation - Individual 6-8 minutes or Team 8-10 minutes
Senior	14-18	Speech - 5 to 8 minutes PSA - 60 seconds Impromptu Speech - 5 minutes Video Communication - 60 to 90 seconds Presentation - Individual 6-8 minutes or Team 8-10 minutes
