When & Where to Enter Livestock Exhibits at the Fair: Clover Kids have the option of leaving their animal exhibits the entire fair or just bringing the exhibit the day of the show (except pigs-they must stay entire fair). If you choose to leave your animal exhibit the entire fair, they need to be entered from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 8. If you choose to bring your exhibit the day of the show - bucket calves, lambs, and goats need to be vet inspected-see times below.
