
Knox County Fair Pre-entry Instructions Entry Deadline Is July 26 for ALL exhibits.

Please follow these instructions for the enclosed entry form(s). Please read carefully. If you have questions, please call the Knox County Extension Office at 288-5611.

Livestock Forms - An entry form is enclosed for each 4-H member who has livestock. **We have highlighted the areas on the entry form that you are enrolled in and have the appropriate ID's on file.** Please indicate the number of animals you are bringing to the fair for stall assignments. Please continue to list all the information and which classes you are entering for rabbit, poultry, cat, dog, companion animals (pets), and horse.



Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) Training: YQCA Training is required for all exhibitors who have food-producing animal projects. This includes beef, swine, sheep, dairy, dairy goat, meat goat, poultry and rabbit. Youth must have completed a YQCA Training Program to exhibit at the fair. Visit https://yqcaprogram.org/ if you need to take the training online.

If a 4-H member is not taking a project to the fair, please cross it out on the entry form and return the form to the Extension Office.

Non-livestock (Static) Forms - An entry form is enclosed for each 4-H member to pre-enter all static exhibits.

Please list the class number for **each** exhibit you are planning to bring to the fair. Even though you may not be sure at this time about some of your exhibits, list them on the entry form if you think there is a possibility you might, so the entry tags are printed. It is important that we have these completed correctly. The class numbers can be found in the Fairbook. The project areas are printed in the Table of Contents. Once you find the project area, the class number is listed in front of the project description. Please, give a simple description of your item. This column is helpful if the entry tag is separated from the article. Fairbook available at https://extension.unl.edu/statewide/knox/fair/

When & Where to Enter Exhibits at the Fair: All exhibits, except the animals, should be entered at the 4-H Exhibit Hall on Wednesday, August 7 from 4:00 to 8:00 p.m.

Horticulture Exhibits (Garden & Flower): Pre-entry is also required on garden and flower exhibits. Pre-enter only 4 entries in Flowers; only 3 entries in Houseplants; and a maximum of 10 entries in Vegetables/Herbs/Fruits with only one exhibit per class number. If you need to bring an exhibit that was not pre-entered, substitutions may be made at check-in.

Recycled Exhibit, Lego Creation, Gnome Exhibit, County Workshop, Clover Camps, & Take-N-Make Exhibits: If you plan to bring exhibits in these areas, please list them on the entry form also. I list of class numbers for each of these exhibits is enclosed.
