

Learning with Daisies

Develop visual discretion, problem-solving skills, color-matching skills, and foster the correspondence of sets to written numerals.

- ► Cut large numbers out of cardstock.
- ► Color each number a different color or use colored cardstock.
- ► Create daisies out of cardstock. (The number will depend on the maturity of the children.)
- ► Color each daisy the same color as its corresponding numeral: for example, four purple daisies for a purple numeral 4.

The children can hang the appropriate number of daisies on the bulletin board next to each number. The children can match the color daisies to the corresponding colored number to make this activity self-correcting.
