## DAWES COUNTY 4-H & FFA PROGRESS SHOW

## **Rules and Regulations 2024**



## **General Show Information:**

- Open to all 4-H and FFA members.
- Exhibitors must be at least 8 and no more than 18 years old before January 1, of the current year.
- The Show Committee will have the final decision on class breaks and registration paper discrepancies.
- Show off trailer
- Dress: Show attire 4-H/FFA shirt not required. NO halter tops or sleeveless shirts/blouses.
- Health Requirements: All livestock are subject to examination, upon arrival, for evidence of infectious or contagious diseases, open wounds and other animal health concerns. If found, animals will not be allowed entrance onto the grounds. Under no circumstances may animals under quarantine be exhibited.

#### Classes:

**Showmanship**: All ages before January 1, of the current year.

Senior Division - 14 and older; Intermediate Division - 11-13; Junior Division - 8-10.

Clover Kids - 5-7 (non-competitive and animals under 350 pounds).

## **Swine Show Information**

- Market Show Only, no breeding gilt classes. Barrows and Gilts show together.
- Exhibitors will declare weights. Weigh cards must be completed and turned in during the designated checkin time and location. The weight listed on the weigh card will become that animal's official declared weight to be used for assignment to a class.
- Wash racks available.
- All market swine must have a current 4-H or FFA ear tag.

## **Sheep & Meat Goat Show Information**

#### **Meat Goats:**

- All meat goats must have a scrapies tag.
- Meat goats will be shown by weight. Does and wethers will show together.
- Goats are to have milk teeth and there shall be no evidence of breaking of the skin or eruption of the two permanent front teeth. Goats must have horns blunted.
- Goats are to be shown with neck chains, halters, or smooth collars only.
- Short scrotum, cyptorchid and buck kids are not eligible.

## **Market Lambs:**

- All market lambs must have a scrapies tag.
- Market lambs will be shown by weight. No re-weighs.

## **Breeding Goat & Breeding Sheep:**

- Ewes and Does ONLY
- All breeding must be identified by scrapie tag and either tattoo.
- Breeding will be grouped by age.

## **Beef Show Information**

## **Breeding Heifers:**

- Heifers must be born between January 2023—June 2024
- All breeding heifers must be identified by legible ear tattoo(s).

## **Market Beef:**

- All market animals must be born in 2023.
- Market Steers and Heifers will be shown by weight. Steers and Heifers will be shown together.
- All market beef must have a current 4-H or FFA ear tag in place to be eligible to show.
