



DNA Samples

- pick up envelopes and return to Extension Office by June 7
- \$7 each to be paid online when you nominate your animal on Show Stock Manager (will inform when available!)

Livestock ID Information

Available at Extension Office:

- · Ear tags required for county-only market beef, sheep, goats, swine, bucket calves
- · EID Tags will be required for market, feeders, and swine attending the State Fair.

NEW! DNA – breeding livestock and feeder calves will now be required to submit DNA sample/envelopes for state fair


- · Tattoos required for registered breeding beef attending the State Fair or EID Tags for commercial breeding beef attending state fair. Breeding beef only attending the county fair can either have a county ear tag and / or tattoo.
- · Registered breeding heifers need their registration papers for check-in at the County and State fair.
- · Rabbits are required to be tattooed.
- · County-only tags: \$1.00
- · EID tags (State Fair): \$2.00
- · All sheep and goats require scrapie tags for County and State Fair.
