#### **Enrollment Updates:**


4-H enrollment for 2024 is now open! Please note, there have been a few changes to make the process easier and faster.

These changes include:

- 1. Project Selection on 4-H Online is optional. You will only need to select the projects you are interested in exploring. This will not determine your county/state fair participation. Also note that the project titles that you will see on the project list are the overarching name of the projects that are available within that area. See picture below for examples)
- a. EXCEPTION: If you are participating in any 4-H shooting sports discipline or the 4-H horse project, you must select those projects when you enroll.
- 2. When choosing your school's name, if your child attends a private school, you will have to go under Madison County Private Schools, and then select your school (See picture below).

#### **Livestock Boosters: Checks Ready!**

## 2024 State Fair Update

The decision has been made to change the age of eligibility in 2024 for all inperson State Fair events (livestock, contest, fashion shows, contests) and other sate competitions (Fonner Park State 4-H Horse Show, PASE, communications contest) to be 8 years of age before January 1 (of the current year). Note: there will be some events that will maintain their ages due to specific program rules (shooting sports, FIRST LEGO league Challenge Robotics). Please check information on each specific event as it becomes available.
