Plant Fair Meeting Minutes

March 9, 2024

Brian Mandal brought the Plant Fair meeting to order at 8:36. Connie Dvorak presented information from Blackburn Manufacturing Company on banners for advertising our plant fair in April. The size decided on was 3 by 6 feet. Norfolk city rules say they are to be 25 feet from any intersection. Permission should be received from businesses they are located on. Several signs will be printed this year. Items discussed – what should be printed, print on one or both sides, arrows on the banners or standing beside, staking the banners, etc. The banners can be placed out on Sunday, April 21st and removed on Saturday, April 27th after the fair finishes. Having a lunch stand at the Ag center is allowed, members not bringing bars are to pay \$10.00 to Linda Douglas or Mary Lux. Members working at the welcome table will eat first on Friday night as customers do come before 5:00. Robin Jones is working on advertising. She handed out ½ sheet, full sheet, and speaker sheet fliers to distribute. New postcards were received for customers to sign for next year's fair. Kathy Duval handed out the list of perennials for the fair. Connie Dvorak said Shamrock will bring the annual plants. Meeting ended @ 9:10.
