## MERRICK COUNTY 4-H SCHOLARSHIP

The Merrick County 4-H Scholarship is offered to encourage Merrick County 4-H members to continue their education.

Application deadline is April 1. Scholarship amount is \$500. Winners will be announced at graduation time each year.

Awards will be granted upon scoring of application including review of Senior Achievement Application, essay and letters of recommendation. A selection committee composed of 4-H Council members will make the final decisions.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Current 4-H member of Merrick County.
- Graduating high school senior at time of application.
- Enrolling in an accredited school (vocational or college) beyond the high school level.

### **Application Requirements**



- Senior Achievement Application.
- A maximum three (3) page essay outlining what 4-H has meant to me with a strong emphasis on how 4-H has impacted my future education plans. Your story should be different from the Dan & Susan Monaghan 4-H Scholarship application.
- One (1) photograph of applicant.
- Two (2) letters of recommendation. One (1) letter of recommendation must come from a 4-H leader, volunteer, mentor, etc. highlighting how you have seen this applicant grow in 4-H.
