

4-H PREMIUM SALE

- A. See General Rules and General Livestock Rules and Regulations.**
- B.** A 5% commission is kept by Nemaha County 4-H Council to be used to benefit the livestock 4-H members and livestock facilities.
- C. Any animal with a late Animal Identification or Green Fair Entry Sheet is not eligible for the Premium Sale.**
- D.** Sale is limited to 2 **feeder or market** animals per 4-H exhibitor. They may sell 2 market beef, 2 pre-market or market swine, 2 feeder or market sheep, 2 feeder or market (meat) goats, 2 market rabbits, 2 market turkeys, a pen of three broilers (considered a unit) or any combination such as: 1 beef and 1 swine or 1 swine and 1 sheep.
- E.** Exhibitors must fill out a Premium Sale Entry Form for each animal they plan to take through the Premium Sale. Forms will be available at livestock check-in and must be completed by NOON the day prior to the Premium Sale. Forms should be turned in to the superintendent or at the Fair Office. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to make sure he/she is signed up for the Premium Sale. Those who do not sign up by the deadline will not sell.
- F.** Appropriate 4-H attire or FFA attire must be worn for the Premium Sale.
- G.** 4-H &/or FFA market livestock will have to be shown at the current year's Nemaha County Fair by the exhibitor to be eligible for the Premium Sale.
- H. **Livestock Premium Sale Checks**** will be held until a written Thank You(s) to your buyer(s) is brought to the Extension Office addressed with a stamp and READY to be mailed by Extension staff.
