GENERAL INFORMATION & EXHIBITING RULES - SCHOOL ENRICHMENT/AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM

- A. The purpose of the School Enrichment/After School Exhibit and/or product is to give those 4-Hers enrolled in the 4-H School Enrichment/After School Classroom an opportunity to showcase the projects they have worked on during the school year.
- B. In the following classes youth may enter an educational exhibit. That may be a poster, display, photographs, charts, notebook, scrapbook or any other exhibit that shows what was learned in the School Enrichment/After School project. A poster may be up to 14" x 22" and a display may not exceed a total exhibit space of 12" deep x 15" wide x 10".
- C. You may also enter the product(s) made e.g. bird feeder, pinwheel, etc.
- D. Each display or product will not be judged, but will receive a \$2.00 premium and a participation ribbon.
