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

Newsletter Delivery Changes

Fruit Sales

Fruit Sales end on Monday, February 12. This is the largest fund-raising effort that the Nemaha County 4-H Council sponsors each year with the 4-H'ers selling fruit. The monies raised through the Fruit Sale provide educational materials, scholarships, and support leadership activities that the 4-H'ers participate in throughout the year. The individual 4-H'ers selling fruit earn Bonus Bucks (\$5.00 in B.B. for every \$50.00 sold) that can be used to pay for camps, trips (CWF), workshops, 4-H t-shirts, and more. Fruit delivery date will be Saturday, March 2, 2024. Be sure to have the delivery date on your calendar. It is very important 4-H members are there to get their orders of fruit and deliver it to their customers. If you cannot be there, YOU must make arrangements to get it picked up as we will not bring it back to the Extension Office and it cannot be left at the 4-H Building.

- February 12 Fruit Sales end After this date you will no longer be able to enter orders online.
- February 13 Leaders collect summary folders from 4-H'ers
- February 15 Leaders turn in Fruit Sales summary folders to Extension Office BY NOON
- March 2 Fruit Delivery (Pick up fruit at the 4-H Building from 8:45 to 10:00 am)

REFUND POLICY: We will not be sorting the mixed boxes again this year, so bad fruit may end up in our customers' hands. We will be happy to exchange it for good fruit. Customers are responsible for bringing the bad fruit to the office by Friday, March 8th, if they want to exchange it. **We encourage families to check their own orders before leaving the building. We will have replacement fruit on site if needed.**

NOTE: The office will print delivery tickets/receipts for ALL orders (online & paper sales). We will attach a note to each receipt that includes thanks, storage suggestions, and the refund policy.

Reminder:

2023 Fruit Sales Bonus Bucks must be spent by March 31, 2024. These bonus bucks are fully transferable to 4-H members within your family. The camp scholarship Bonus Bucks must be used by October 31, 2024. Camp scholarship bonus bucks are transferable to family members at 50% (i.e. \$150 in Bonus Bucks transfers as \$75.)

All participants must be enrolled in 4-H at v2.4honline.com with the air pistol and air rifle project selected if they want to participate in both or just choose one or the other. Enrollment includes a waiver for parents to sign that must be completed before participation is allowed. This year again we will be shooting in the 4-H building. How many flights we have will depend on how many kids sign-up. We can have 10 kids on the firing line at a time, but we only have so many firearms. If you have your own air rifle or air pistol and eye protection, please bring them. Participation in 3 practices is required to be able to compete in the competition. These practices will also transfer if you want to compete in the .22 or BB Gun competitions later in the year.

HUNTER SAFETY COURSE: This course is scheduled for **Thursday, March 14 (6-9 pm), Friday, March 15 (6-9) and Saturday, March 16 (8 am-2 pm) at the Auburn Senior Center.** (Youth must attend all 3 days.) This training is for Firearm and Archery Safety. Youth should be 11 years of age to attend.

All 4-Hers who plan to participate in the Trap (Shotgun), and/or .22 Rifle (Smallbore) projects will need to have their Hunter Certification to participate in these events. Please go ahead and plan to attend this course and be ready for 4-H Shooting Sports Contests. You **must pre-register** for this course (**when it comes available**) at: https://outdoornebraska.gov/huntereducation/. At the website click on Firearm Hunter Education Classroom Courses. Find the date of this session; click on the "Register Now" button. Registration information is entered on a secure website and the last 4 digits of the participant's SSN is required. Miscellaneous

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA)

4-H members who plan to enroll in any of the following projects – swine, beef, sheep, dairy, meat goat, dairy goat, rabbits and/or poultry will need to have completed Quality Assurance Certification on or before Fair Entry Date on June 15th.

Certification will be done via YQCA online course. It is found at https://ygcaprogram.org.

However, all new volunteers serving in direct roles, such as club leader, project leader, or workshop presenter, are required to complete the orientation. Fair Premium Sale Weight Requirements:

Each livestock division will have weight requirements for premium sale eligibility. Livestock not meeting min or max weight requirements will not be eligible for the premium sale.

Beef: Market Steers: 1000 lbs; Market Heifers: 900 lbs

Broilers: 4 lbs for females and 5

lbs for males

Meat Goats: 50 lbs

Rabbit: Single Fryer: 3.5 lbs min & 5.5 lbs max; Roaster: 5.5

lbs min & 9 lbs max; Stewers: 8 lbs min

Wool Sheep: 100 lbs; Hair Sheep: 70 lbs.

Swine: 230 lbs min & 320 lbs max

PRINCESS OF INDIA NASTURTIUM

WHAT IS THE SPECIAL GARDEN PROJECT? This project is open to all youth of 4-H age and it will give them the opportunity to learn about growing, harvesting, and exhibiting this unique flower.

The Special Gardening Project lets 4-H members try their hand at growing unusual vegetables, flowers, and herbs. The project allows experienced 4-H gardeners to grow something fun, new, and different while letting those new to gardening get their feet wet in this project area.

The focus of the 2024 project is the Princess of India Nasturtium. This Victorian-era heirloom flower can be grown in a variety of ways including in containers. It provides a splash of color from its scarlet flowers and much of the plant can be eaten.

The Nebraska Extension Special Agronomy Project gives 4-H members an opportunity to experience a crop that is grown, was grown or has the potential to be grown in Nebraska. Youth participate by receiving seed and resources to grow the crop, research traits of the crop and determine the viability of that crop in the part of the state they live. The project allows 4-H members interested in agronomy to grow something fun, new, and different. This year, we honor a crop grown in the panhandle!

In the fourth year of the special agronomy project, youth will explore sugar beets! Sugar beets are a major contributor to the U.S. sweetener industry and occur in a vast range of different food products. Be eligible to enter an exhibit at both the County and/or State Fair in the agronomy project area.
