Dawes County Camper Spot Guidelines

The Dawes County Fairgrounds has eight camper spots with hookups as of May 2023. The Fairgrounds does have additional grass areas that families can bring their own generator if they wish. Camper hookups are intended for the convenience of 4-H families and Ag Society members. The Dawes County Agriculture Society is not liable for any damage to individual campers or injuries as a result of the use of said campers during the entire duration of stay at the Dawes County Fairgrounds.

<u>Families interested in obtaining a camper spot must call or inform the Dawes County Extension Office by July 1st of the current year.</u> When calling the Extension Office, please share name and phone number. The Dawes County Ag Society is asking families to only call if you live 15+ miles away from the Fairgrounds. The Dawes County Extension Office will confirm that families live 15+ miles away from the Fairgrounds. After July 1st, the Dawes County Extension Office will put all names into a drawing. The first eight families drawn will receive a camper hookup spot. Families will receive a phone call if they receive a spot.

The fee for the camper hookup spot will be \$25 per day. If you receive a camper hookup, you are expected to stay the entire week. Keep in mind if a camper is put in place weeks before the county fair, families will be charged \$25 for each day.

Families will have to pay before getting the box unlocked. The Dawes 4-H Assistant (Tessa) will be handling the unlocking. You may call her at the Extension Office (308)432-3373 or (308)530-3083. Please use her cell number respectively. Checks are payable to the Dawes County Agricultural Society.

The Extension Office is handling camper reservations as a courtesy to the Ag Society. We will not tolerate families unplugging or moving another family's camper. Please do your best to resolve issues on your own.

Please understand that the Dawes County Ag Society and Dawes County Extension Office are trying to make the camper spot process fair and organized for everyone. We do have hopes to add more camper hookups soon.
