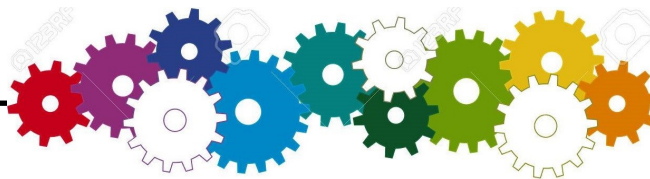


4-H Marvel Makers
